## Why We Do the Work

Top Takeaways from the Achieving Diversity in the U.S. Cybersecurity Industry Research independently conducted by Ponemon Institute LLC (Sponsored by Security Innovation and Cyversity)

-  Women are underrepresented in the cybersecurity profession.
-  More mentoring and recruitment of diverse IT security practitioners needs to be done.
-  Not all jobs require an extensive background and education in cybersecurity.
-  Inability to retain diverse talent makes it difficult to close the diversity gap.
-  To improve diversity in the workforce, organizations should ensure job candidates understand the expectations they have when hiring.
-  There is a need to increase veteran awareness of the field and prepare veterans for the industry.

Cyversity is committed to addressing the critical diversity gap in the cybersecurity industry. In a sector struggling with underrepresentation—particularly among women, veterans, and minority communities—we recognize that diverse perspectives are essential to tackling the rapidly evolving landscape of cyber threats.

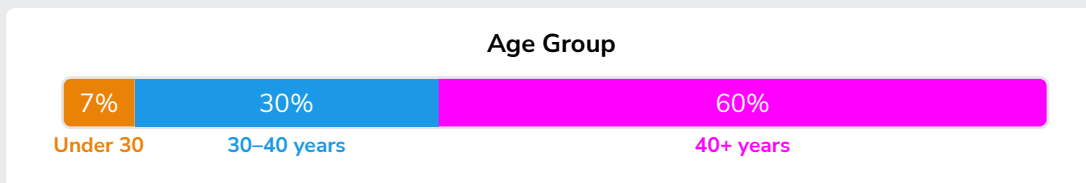
The data speaks for itself: According to Forbes, "Diverse teams deliver 60% better results and make better decisions 87% of the time." McKinsey's research echoes this, showing that "companies in the top quartile for gender and ethnic diversity outperform their counterparts." Yet, while 69% of cybersecurity professionals value diversity, only 39% work in diverse environments. This gap underscores the need for more inclusive teams, especially as cyber-attacks become more frequent and sophisticated.

Additionally, the industry faces a significant retention challenge, with the Kapur Center estimating that stereotypes and harassment in the workplace cost the industry \$16 billion annually. Creating inclusive and supportive environments can help address this issue, as research shows that over 75% of employees prioritize workplace diversity.

As diversity becomes a national priority, fostering a more inclusive cybersecurity workforce is not just a moral imperative—it's a critical strategy for securing our digital future.

## Why Cyversity Exists

In 2022, the global cybersecurity workforce surged to 4.7 million, marking an 11.1% annual increase, equating to 464,000 new jobs. Despite this growth, the demand for cybersecurity professionals is outpacing supply. According to (ISC)<sup>2</sup>, the workforce gap expanded by 26.2% year-over-year, underscoring the urgent need for increased numbers and greater diversity in this crucial profession.

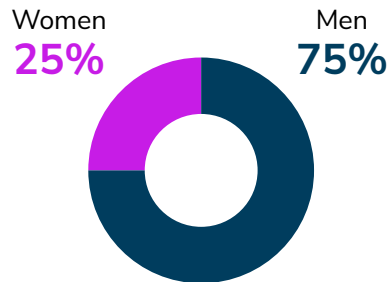

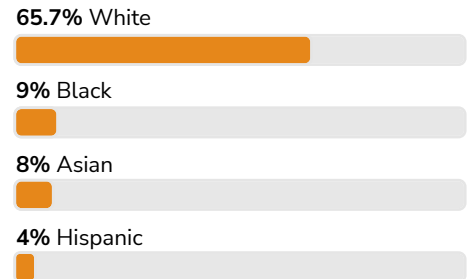

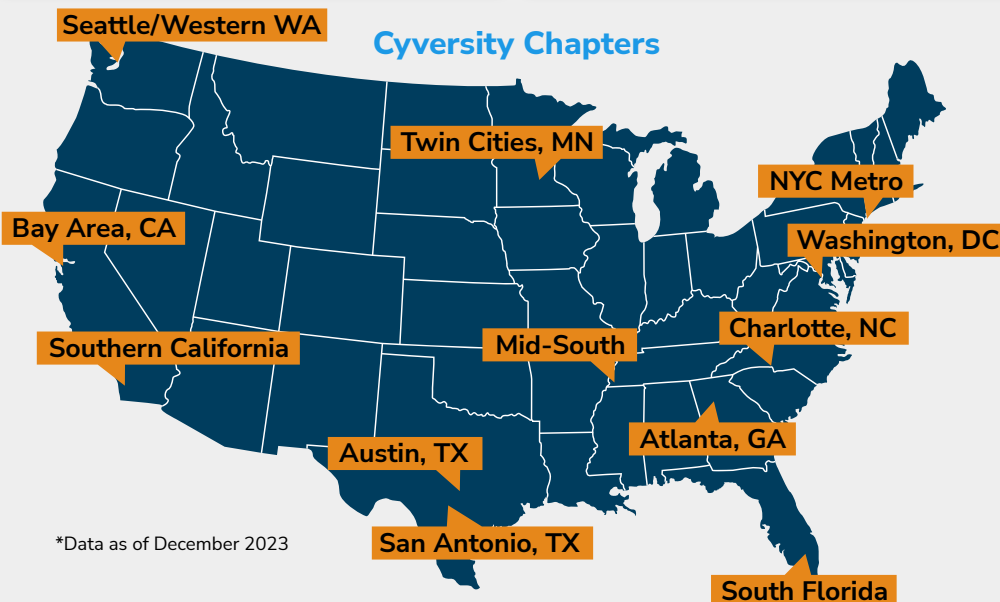
### Demographics



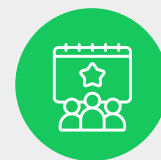

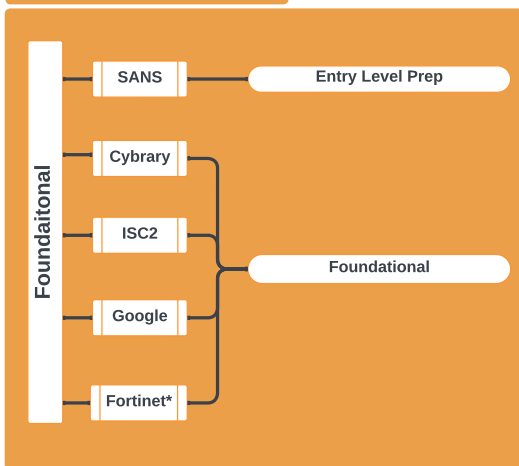


## SPONSOR TRAINING FOR OUR MEMBERS

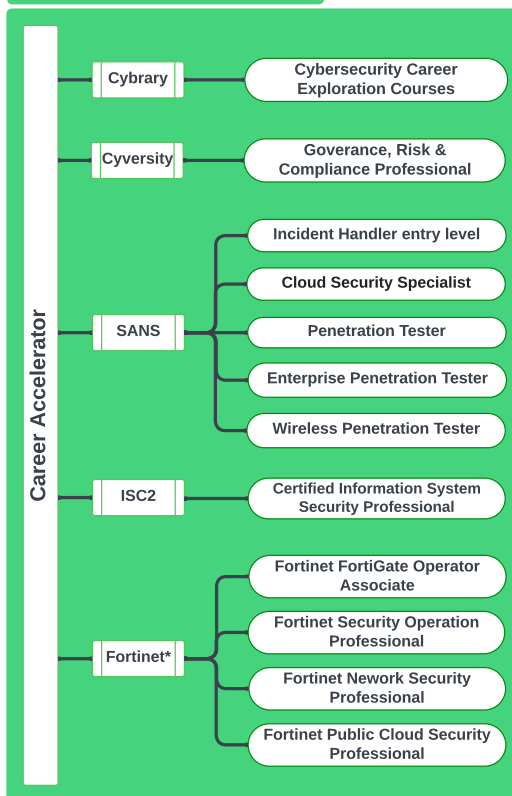

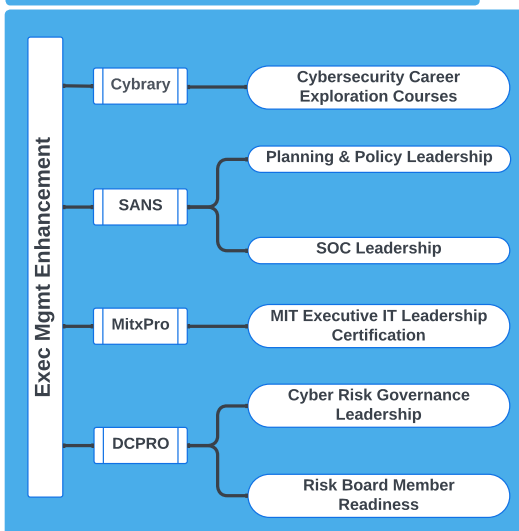
### Foundational - Entry Level

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Cyversity Professionals or their designated representatives ("ORGANIZER") reserves the right to reject any prospective sponsor company ("SPONSOR") that it deems inappropriate. 'SPONSOR' includes any person, firm, or company, corporation, institution, association or committee to whom the sponsorship is allocated. 'VENUE' refers to the location where the event is being held.

2. Payment is due within 30-days of invoice unless otherwise agreed in writing by Organizer. If payment has not been made by the relevant deadline according to the production schedule provided by the Organizer, the Organizer reserves the right to decline to convey the relevant benefit or pass on costs incurred because of the delay.
3. Travel and accommodation expenses are not included in the sponsorship fee. Sponsors and Event attendees are responsible for making their own arrangements.
4. All sponsorship materials must be submitted within the production schedule provided by the Organizer.
5. Sponsors may not sublet, assign or apportion any part of the item(s) sponsored nor represent, advertise or distribute literature or materials for the products or services of any other firm or organization except as approved in writing by Organizer.
6. The organizer will not be liable for damage or loss to a Sponsor's properties through fire, theft, accident or any other cause, whether the result of negligence or otherwise.

8. The sponsorship fees do not include event registration unless specifically stated in the sponsorship opportunity details.
